Staying Above Water...

Sharks defenseman Brennan Evans has been steady all season. The Alberta native holds a team-high plus-14 this season over 51 games played. Evans has been on the minus side of things just 12 times all season. The blueliner also provides a sense of security for his teammates as the resident pugilist with a team-high 122 penalty minutes.

Greiss Lightning...

Sharks rookie netminder Thomas Greiss picked up his 11th win of the season after making 20 saves against the Springfield Falcons on Saturday. The Koln, Germany native owns a goals-against average of 2.69 and a save percentage of .909. Greiss ranks in the top 20 goaltenders of the league in both categories.
